

Norman Touet Neel

Norman Touet Neel (1907-1957), 49, died from self-inflicted bullet wounds at his Georgetown home Saturday.

County Judge William E. Warren, acting as coroner, ruled death by suicide. Sheriff Walt Pellicer said the man had been in poor health for some time.

Neel, a fisherman, came to Georgetown during 1952 from Short Hills, N.J.

Mrs. Neel was in the bathroom of her home when she heard a shot fired, she told Sheriff Pellicer, who said he found a .22 automatic by the body when he arrived at the scene.

Funeral services, handled at Clayton Frank and Sons of Crescent City, will be held at 10:30 tomorrow morning.

Neel is survived by his wife; a son, Peter S. Neel, USN; and a daughter, Ellita Carol Neel of Short Hills.
