

Johnson, Woodrow Wilson

Funeral rites for Woodrow Wilson Johnson (1915-1948), who died suddenly Wednesday at his home at Johnson, were held Thursday afternoon at the Johnson Presbyterian Church, with Rev. Henry Reaves of Gainesville, and Rev. John Largent of Palatka, officiating. Burial was in the Johnson Cemetery, with W. Carl Davis and Son in charge.

Mr. Johnson was born at Johnson on February 12, 1915, and had spent practically his entire lifetime in that community. He was a member of the Presbyterian Church. He is survived by his father, Joseph E. Johnson and two sisters, Mrs. Leonard Paul of Daytona Beach, and Mrs. Lydia Hudson of Palatka and a brother, Tom Johnson of Palatka.
